Dear Parents / Guardians,

Today saw the end of our two-week summer scheme and what a fantastic two weeks the children have had. I would like to take this opportunity to thank Miss McMullan, our whole support staff team and Antrim Playball for offering this excellent provision during the summer holidays.

We hope you have all enjoyed some rest and family fun in the summer months and that all of our children are looking forward to coming back to school.

Just as a reminder that all children in **Primary 2-7** should attend the two days of induction on **Thursday 26th and Friday 27th August 2021, 8.45am-12pm**. These days will allow pupils to settle into their new class structure and set class routines and rules.

Primary 1 pupils will have received letters which invited them to attend one session on **either** Thursday 26th **or** Friday 27th August 2021. If you have mislaid this letter, please contact me on emccaffery943@c2kni.net to confirm your child's session.

School will then be closed on Monday 30th August and Tuesday 31st August 2021.

All pupils will then return to their full timetables from Wednesday 1st September 2021.

Pupils in Primary 1 should bring the book bag we supplied and a small named lunch box to carry their snack and drink. Pupils in Primary 2-7 should bring a named school bag that can carry their raincoats, lunch, drinks and home learning folders. All items sent into school, including coats, hats, scarves, gloves, uniform, snack boxes, pencil cases, drinks bottles etc should be labelled with your child's names.
