Happy New Year!

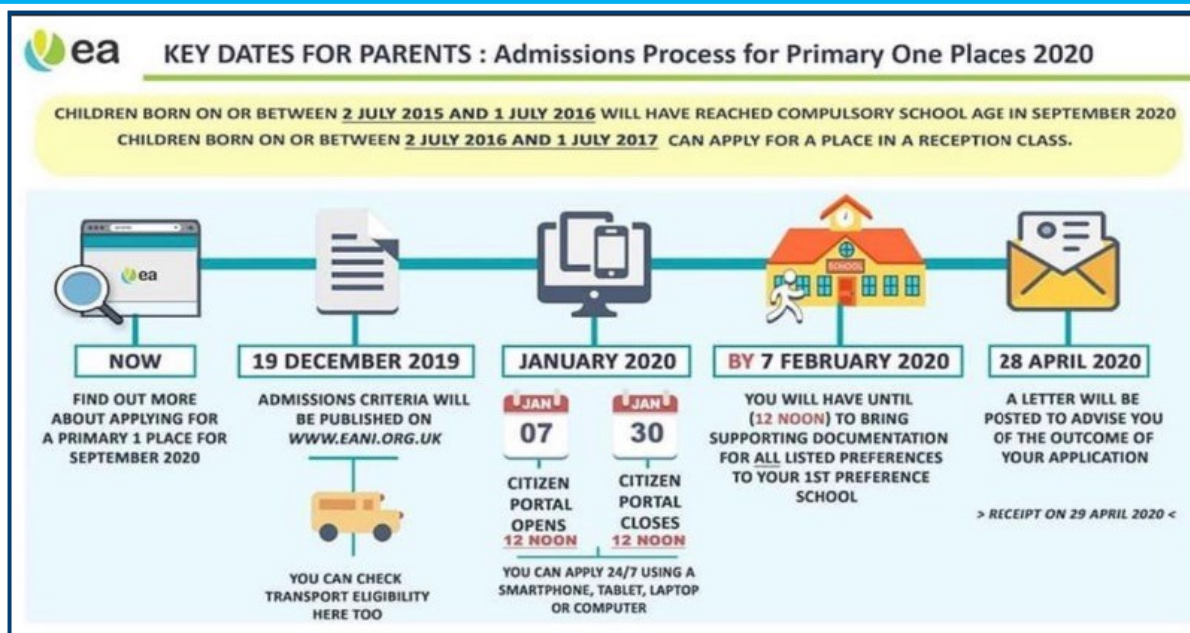

Drop off and Collection

Over recent weeks we have been trialling new safeguarding routines in the mornings.

Please note the carpark is now closed to all traffic between 8.45am and 9am and a member of staff will be present on the gate to supervise entry.

We would ask that parents / guardians:-

- continue to supervise younger pupils to the gate
- supervise their children crossing the road.
- to observe the no parking area at the front of the school. (Any cars parked on the zig zag lines block the view of adults who are supervising entry or exit.)
- are courteous to our neighbours and do not block or obscure the entry to their lane ways.

As pupil numbers continue to increase, we will continue to review these arrangements.

Lunches, Tickets, Trips and Refund Policy

In order to secure bookings we have to confirm places prior to attendance at any shows, concerts or on trips. This means that once confirmed and paid, bookings are non refundable. Unfortunately with the growing pressures on school budgets, a refund can only be given if we receive a discount or refund for your child's place.

However, we are able to cancel lunches and any monies paid can be transferred to cover lunches the following week.

Cold, Flu and Winter Bugs

This time of year always sees a significant increase in the numbers of children with coughs, colds and flu like symptoms. In order to protect other children from these winter viruses, we would ask you to keep your child at home if they are unwell. It would also be really helpful if each child could bring in a box of tissues for use in their classroom.

The Public Health Agency also recommend that any children suffering with vomiting or diarrhoea do not attend school for 48 hours after the last bout of sickness.
